Along with S.O.A.P. memorizing one scripture a week will help you make Gods word's apart of your life.

S Exodus 3

- O
1. What did Moses see on fire in the desert? Who appeared in it?
 2. What did God tell Moses to do in verse 5? What was his response in verse 6?

A

In Biblical times, removing your shoes was an act of reverence. God was teaching Moses that He should be treated with respect and sincerity. How can you show respect to God?

P

God, You are great and You are the Lord and most worthy of praise; You are to be feared (respected/revered) above everything. There is none like You. (Psalm 96:4)

Day 1

S Exodus 4

- O
1. What were some of the excuses Moses gave to God?
 2. What did God say in response to each of Moses's excuses?

A

Moses was more focused on his weaknesses than on God's ability to help him. Where is a place God is challenging you to do something, but you are afraid? What can you do to focus on God more than your fear?

P

Lord, I declare that I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength. (Phil 4:13)

S Exodus 5

- O
1. What did Pharaoh say when Moses asked him to let the people go?
 2. As punishment, what did Pharaoh make the Israelites do?

A

Pharaoh would not listen to Moses because he did not know God. When has anyone rejected you when you talked to them about God? What can you do to prepare yourself before talking to someone like Pharaoh?

P

Lord, I ask that _____ would know that You, O Lord, are God. Turn _____ heart to You. (1 Kings 18:37)

Day 3

S Exodus 6

- O**
1. In verses 6 - 8, what did God say he was going to do for the Israelites?
 2. When Moses told the Israelites God's promises, how did they respond?

A Moses continued to obey God even though no one would listen to him or believe him. Anyone can obey God when the task is easy. What can you do when God asks you to do something that you believe is hard to do?

Day 4

P Lord, even when I can't see anything happening or people give me a hard time, I will focus on You and trust You with the results.

S Exodus 7

1. What happened to Aaron's staff? What did Aaron's staff do to the magicians' staff?
 2. What happened to the Nile River?

A God performed miracles, and still Pharaoh did not listen to Moses or believe him. Pharaoh's heart became hard. What can you do to guard your heart and not let your heart become hard?

Day 5

P Teach me Your way, Lord, that I may walk *and* live in Your truth; direct *and* unite my heart [solely, reverently] to fear *and* honor Your name. (Psalm 86:11)

1. Name the 3 plagues that occurred in this chapter. Who got rid of the frogs and flies?
 2. Why did God not have the plague of flies occur in Goshen?

A This is the 4th time Moses went to Pharaoh to let him know what would happen if he didn't let the Israelites go and the 4th time Pharaoh did not keep his word. When have you given your word to someone and have not kept it? What steps can you take to make sure you do what you say?

Day 6

P Lord, I'm seeing that it is important to do what I say I will do. Forgive me when I haven't kept my word. I will go to ____ to ask them to forgive me as well.

1. What 3 plagues occurred in this chapter?
 2. How did Pharaoh respond after the plague of hail? How did Moses reply?

A Moses may have been tired and discouraged dealing with Pharaoh, but he still obeyed God. How can you not become discouraged when someone is difficult? How can you keep focused on what God wants you to do?

P Lord show me your ways, guide me in your truths and teach me. (Psalm 25:4,5)
